Field Day results have been sent in and we had 2752 QSO's after dups. This is a little down from last year. However, our total score will go up because we had 1613 QSO's on CW and 1139 QSO's on SSB. With the CW multiplier, this is equivalent to 4365 QSO's.

Contest season is fast approaching. Start thinking now about station improvements and getting prepared for the pileups. Try especially hard to enter all the contests that have a club aggregate score.
